PAINT & POWDER CLUB MAKES \$27,750 DONATION TO FRANCISCAN CENTER

On Friday, July 11, 2008, the president and president-elect of the Paint and Powder Club presented a check for \$27,750 to the Franciscan Center. Founded in 1893, the Paint and Powder Club is one of the nation's oldest performing arts organizations; its annual charitable activities include a ball and an original theatrical performance.

"We are thrilled to have been selected by the Paint and Powder Club," said Franciscan Center president and chief executive Karen Heyward-West, "Their contribution will help make up for a recent shortfall in donations due to the economic downturn."

The Franciscan Center was founded in 1968 by the Franciscan Sisters of Baltimore, a religious order that has fed the city's hungry since 1891. Located in lower Charles Village, its programs include a food pantry; a weekday hot lunch; medical screenings and treatment; HIV/AIDS outreach; emergency services; men's clothing distribution and a technology resource center. The Center, which serves the needy regardless of age, race, creed or national origin, holds the Maryland Nonprofits Standards for Excellence certification.
